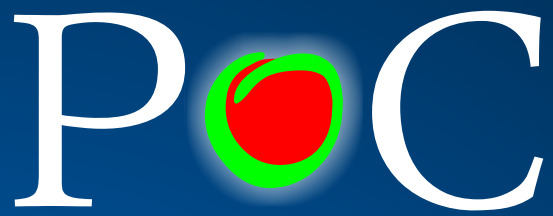

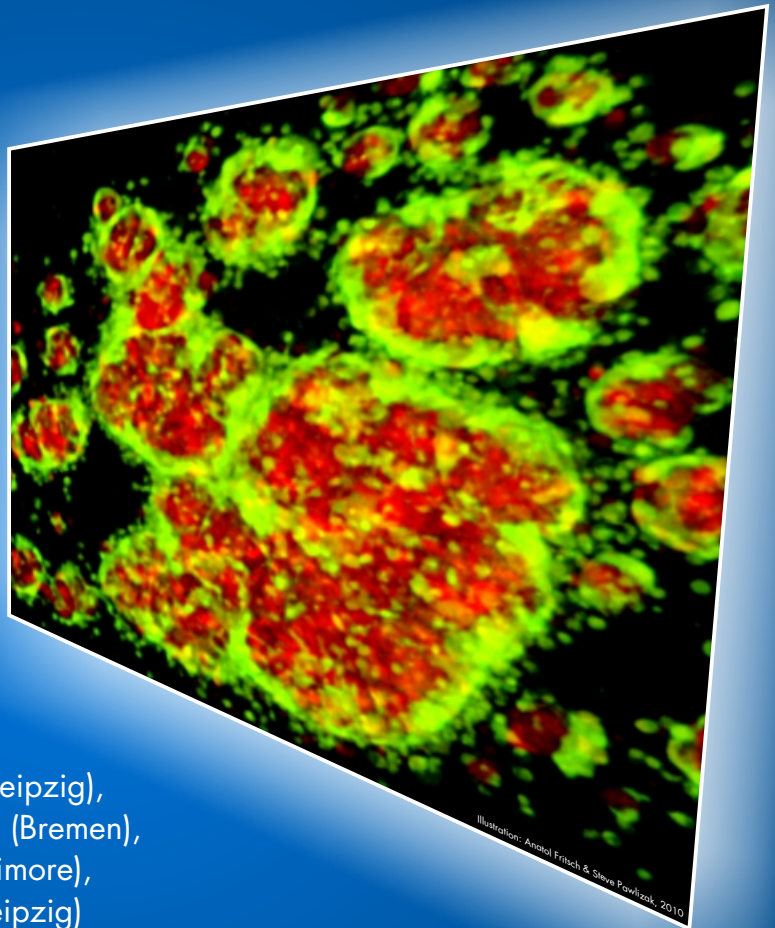
The meeting aims to assemble scientists worldwide pioneering in the investigation of the physical mechanisms underlying cancer progression.
